

## The Clinton Township Board of Trustees

A special meeting of the Clinton Township Board of Trustees was held on August 22<sup>nd</sup> at 10am at 373 S. High St. The Board met with members from the Franklin County Prosecutors office and the office of Economic Development. Present were Trustees Jane Cera, Carl Reardon, Aliena Sword, and Township Administrator Kevin Vaughn. Adria Fields, Nick Sousa, and Matt Brown were present from the County.

### GENERAL

During a lengthy conversation, Board members expressed some of the frustration the Township has endured with the timing of code enforcement. County officials explained the timelines that take place from a zoning complaint until a court date which can be some 60 days later. All parties agreed to work together to do it was possible to move complaints forward in a more efficient manner, including taking a report straight to complaint, which would help shorten the timeline for re-occurring offenses. The board was very supportive of this becoming standard practice.

After the conversation with County officials ended, the Board considered the following time-sensitive purchase orders.
