The Meeting of the Clinton Township Board of Trustees was held on June 27th at 7pm at 999 Chambers Rd Present were Trustees Jane Cera, Carl Reardon, and Aliena Sword, Fiscal Officer Deb Steele, Fire Chief Fraley, Police Chief Jones, Superintendent of Roads Villa, and several residents.

GENERAL

Res. No. 18-06-028 Motion by Trustee Cera to accept the resignation of Township Manager Skip Apple. 2nd Trustee Reardon. Vote: Trustee Sword – Yes, Trustee Reardon – Yes, Trustee Cera – Yes

Resident Bobbie Olt sarcastically congratulated Trustee Cera for “getting rid of” former Township Manager Apple. Ms. Olt implied that Trustee Cera tried to do so once before when Mr. Apple resigned in 2016, and was finally successful. Trustee Cera stated that anyone inside the Township offices who had knowledge of recent events, knew that Mr. Apple's resignation had nothing to do with her.

Trustee Reardon expressed that Mr. Apple’s service to the township was extensive and he will be missed. Trustee Cera and Sword agreed.

Trustee Cera introduced Mr. Vaughn who is coming from Village of Plain City where he helped obtain almost \$1M in grants.

Trustee Reardon stated that the Board sent a lot of time reviewing really great candidates for the position of Township Administrator. Trustee Reardon feels that Mr. Vaughn has done a variety of roles and brings a diverse skill set.

Trustee Sword stated the whole team is excited to have him on Board.

Res. No. 18-06-029 Motion by Trustee Cera to adopt the document Resolution 18-06-029 as written, which in short, outlines the terms under which Mr. Kevin Vaughn is to be salaried as an at-will employee of the Board of Trustees, as the Clinton Township Administrator earning \$85,000.00 a year with 200hrs of vacation and an annual credit of \$3,600 toward vehicle expenses. Hiring date is effective July 9th 2018, and his salary is to be paid from 1000-110-131. 2nd Trustee Sword. Vote: Trustee Sword – Yes, Trustee Reardon – Yes, Trustee Cera –Yes

Trustee Cera moved to adjourn and Trustee Reardon 2nd
